# PTSD AND WELL BEING

Helping Veterans with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder at American Legion Post 519

Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) can show up unexpectedly throughout a Veteran's life. It can present in relationships, career's, hobbies and often interferes with joy, peace and sleep. Most suffer in silence and their symptoms are often not understood or noticed. The stigma that Veterans can just "Soldier On" is a barrier to getting help. When PTSD is not recognized or treated, it can become chronic over time. Brain changes may make recovery harder, symptoms can worsen, and daily life can be deeply disrupted. For Veterans, untreated PTSD significantly increases the risk of suicide.

As I write this article, I wonder how we at Post 519 can help in simple meaningful ways. Here are some thoughts:

1. Learning about PTSD: Nightmares, avoidance, quick temper, triggers such as fireworks, large crowds, aircraft, loud noises; being on guard, feeling of doom or not being safe, feeling like you are back at the trauma are all signs of PTSD. The 4 F's is an easy way to understand PTSD: Fight, Flight, Freeze, Fawn (people pleasing).

2. Understanding how PTSD can show up: An example of how it can show up is: A Veteran is sitting facing the door, watching everything going on, fidgeting and very reactive and startled when someone laughs or talks loudly, or yells. When you engage with this Veteran, they could be very edgy because they don't feel safe.

3. What can you do to help in the moment: Help them understand they are safe and that you have their back. Pull them aside to a quieter spot to talk can often break the reaction. Help them know they are not alone and check in on them after the incident. A quick text or call can save a life or provide much needed comfort.

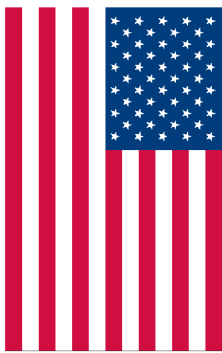

## ALA PRESIDENTS MESSAGE

As April approaches and Unit 519 will host the Girls State Tea, people ask us what Girls State is. Since its inception in 1937, Girls State has enriched the lives of thousands of young women across the United States. Many alumni go on to become leaders in their communities, pursue careers in public service, and advocate for positive change. The program is recognized as a steppingstone for women interested in government, law, and civic engagement.

Girls State is an educational program designed to empower young women by providing hands-on experience in government and civic leadership. This program encourages high school juniors to learn about the political system, develop leadership skills, and foster patriotism.

The primary goal of Girls State is to teach participants about the structure of local, state, and federal government. Through simulations and interactive activities, young women gain a deeper understanding of their civic responsibilities and the democratic process. The program also aims to build confidence, enhance communication skills, and inspire commitment to community service.

Girls State takes place over the course of a week at a college or university campus. Participants, known as "delegates," are assigned to fictional political parties and municipalities. Throughout the week, they run for office, conduct elections, draft legislation, and participate in debates. This immersive experience mirrors the real workings of government and encourages teamwork and critical thinking.

Our Girls State Chairs, Jennifer Hatfield and Debbie Kroodsma conduct interviews at Cathedral City High School, Palm Springs High School and Desert Hot Springs High School. They can interview up to 5 girls that are juniors and are at the top of their class. After the girls attend the California program, two delegates from every Girls State program are selected to attend the American Legion Auxiliary Girls Nation in Washington, D.C. There, participants expand their experience by engaging in a national legislative session, meeting federal officials, and visiting historic sites.

The American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program is a transformative experience for high school girls. By promoting leadership, citizenship, and civic education, it prepares the next generation of female leaders to make meaningful contributions to society. Please join us April 25, at noon to be inspired and have some fun with our future leaders.
