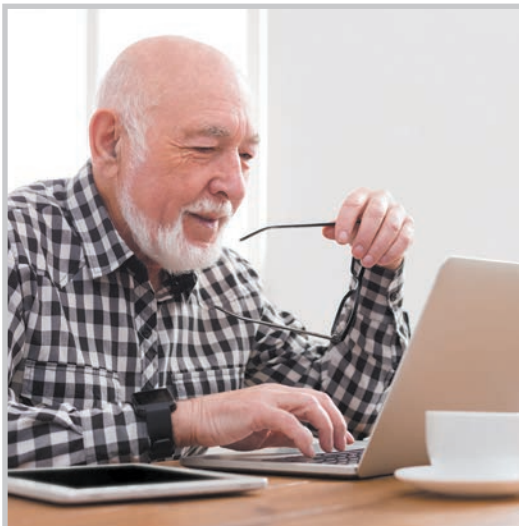

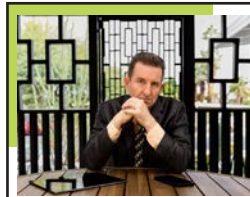

Last month some of our American Legion Auxiliary members participated in the “Aqua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians” Turkey Donations.

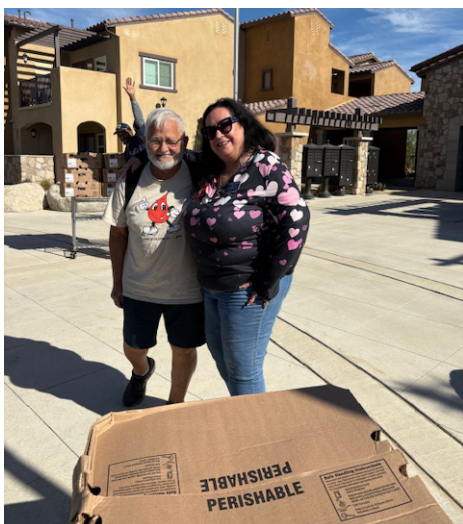
It was an utmost amazing and exhilarating day to be honored by them.

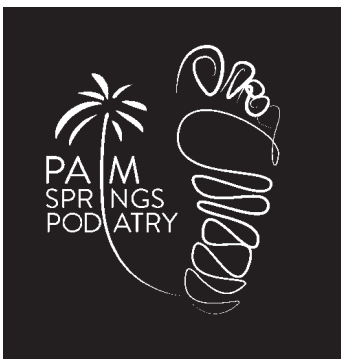
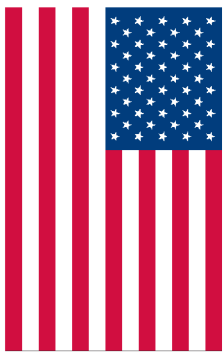
From there location on Diana Shore, we loaded the 57 turkeys and went directly to Veterans Village in Cathedral City.

VETERAN OF THE MONTH

I served in the U.S. Navy from October 1972 until retirement in January 1993. 20 years of acquiring new skills, exploring new lands here at home and abroad, plenty of adventure, and most importantly making friends with individuals from all across this great nation of ours. My career took me to 1st Puerto Rico being the first woman stationed in San Juan Puerto Rico. Afterwards, I went to San Diego, then Hawaii, Guam, then back to San Diego for shipboard duty. There were temporary duties in the Philippines and Japan. For two years, I played on the Navy's All Woman's Softball team and sometimes supplemented playing on my division's men's team. While on active duty, I had the opportunity to do a day cruise onboard the USS Gurnard, SSN 662 submarine and they even let me pilot the USS Gurnard and I dove her to approximately 700 feet. There were some hairy times at sea too. While onboard a North Pac cruise, my ship got caught in a bad storm in the straits of Juan de Fuca and we came very close to capsizing. Honestly, I really shouldn't be here today as that ship (by all standards) should have capsized. It is quite a ride doing 40 degree rolls at sea. At one point in my career, I became a teletype repair person, and there wasn't a piece of teletype gear I couldn't repair. (Don't tell me women are not mechanically inclined) I went on and became Chief in charge of radio communications onboard the USS Dixon AS-37. I advanced to E-8 – Radioman Senior Chief and wrapped up my career as the 1st women to go onboard combatant vessels with Fleet Training Group for refresher trainings commonly known as the "dreaded" Ref Tra's. My part was to simulate combat readiness in casualty scenario and train the radio crew in casualty communications. 100% of the time I was the only female onboard with a crew of 3000 men doing this work as my niche was amphibious vessels. I absolutely loved this job and was happy that I retired from USN on a very happy & satisfied note. I have two adult children who I am extremely proud of – Robert who is a San Diego S.W.A.T police officer and my daughter Caitlin an accountant. AND, 3 wonderful & talented grandchildren, Aidin, Hailey & Arya. Respectfully, **Rusanne Anthony RMCS (SW) USN Retired**

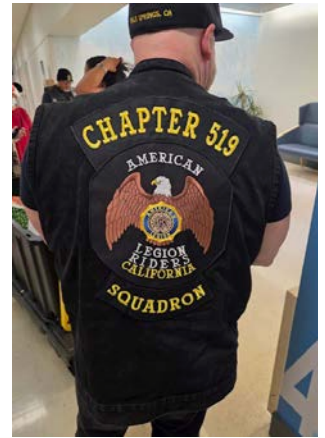

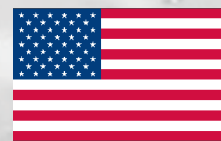

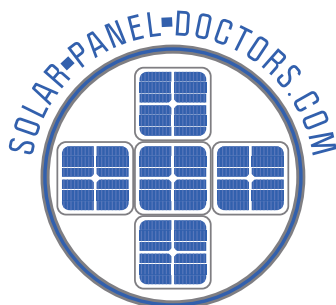
