1. Chef Replacement and Menu Changes •

The current chef was fired due to inefficiency and menu issues.

A new cook from loco Charlie's will replace the previous chef.

Menu items, including toast and a potential Mexican dish, will be updated. Fri, Lunch And Dinner Sunday Brunch

2. Payment Plan and Overhead Costs •

The new chef is dissatisfied with the current payment of \$1,500 a month.

Increased overhead costs include workers' comp, insurance, taxes, and fees.

Further discussions on the payment plan will be held.

3. Cleaning Concerns and Kitchen Hygiene •

The kitchen faced cleanliness issues, including old fryer oil and dirty equipment.

Efforts were made to clean and sanitize the kitchen, including addressing vermin problems.

Ongoing cleaning tasks, such as ceiling cleaning, were discussed.(Motion To Have A Major Cleaning Of The Post Interior (Motion Passed)

4. Entertainment Contract Termination •

Issues with the current entertainer's behavior and attitude were raised.

The decision was made to terminate the entertainer's contract due to disruptive behavior and threats.

Concerns about vaping, drinking, and disruptive conduct during performances were addressed.

5. Employee Termination Process •

If an Volunteer causes trouble, the process will be followed.

(Motion) Lee Wilson is responsible for informing Denise that her services are no longer needed.(Motion Passed)

6. Handling Incidents and Legal Threats •

Concerns raised about legal threats and potential lawsuits.

Protocol discussed for dealing with individuals threatening legal action.

7. Facility Updates and Maintenance •

Introduction of a new ice maker generating excess ice.

The ice machine is getting stuck at night, requiring manual intervention to clear it out.

AC repair issues and the need for electrical panel repair were discussed.

8. Staff Behavior and Policy Updates •

Discussion on Volunteer's negative attitude towards the post and customers, leading to corrective actions.

Plans to address problematic behavior of Volunteer's through verbal and written warnings.

Discussion on the policy regarding staff wearing political attire in the post.

9. Financial Concerns and Fundraising •

Disclosure of a \$25,000 loan repayment obligation to the federal government.

(Motion) to increase lotto bank to \$200 for larger payouts.(Motion Passed)

Discussion on organizing a donation blitz and seeking contributions from big donors.

10. Security and Compliance Issues •

Incident of a

Non member withdrawing \$3,400 from the ATM with a hacked card.

Concerns raised about the security of the ATM and potential risks to the Legion line.
