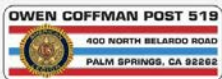

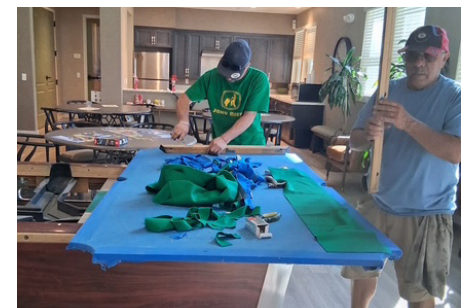
ALA DONATION TO VETERANS VILLAGE

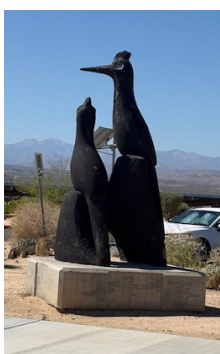
ALA PRESIDENT MESSAGE

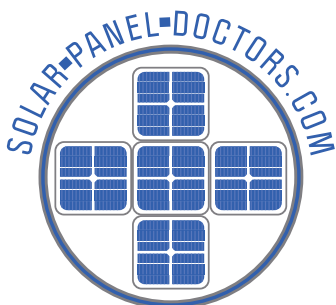
